Stormwater & Permeability

- Environmental awareness and increased statewide and municipal regulation has made permeable pavement options more desirable
- As environmental awareness increases and stormwater management practices evolve, permeable paving is becoming more common
- Municipalities are starting to require that a minimum percentage of paving be permeable in order to infiltrate stormwater and lessen the burden on sewer systems.

Case Study

Nashville, TN

- Trend: municipalities use stormwater fee increases to encourage use of permeable concrete pavement, porous asphalt, and Permeable concrete
